Uniform (Colors)	Dress Code
<p><u>SHIRTS/SWEATERS:</u></p> <p>TK-5: Solid White or Light/Dark Blue (With Collar Preferred)</p> <p>6-8: Solid White, Light/Dark Blue, or Gold (With Collar Preferred)</p> <p>TK-8: Cubberley Spirit Wear can be worn every day; college shirts may be worn on Fridays.</p>	<p><u>SHIRTS/SWEATERS:</u></p> <p>*Proper size and not inside-out</p> <p>*Undershirts must also be uniform colors</p> <p>*No tank tops, spaghetti straps, halters, strapless</p> <p>*No sports jerseys</p> <p>*No logos except for Cubberley/District logos</p> <p>*No non-uniform shirts/sweaters should be worn on top of uniform shirts</p>
<p><u>PANTS/SHORTS/SKIRTS/DRESSES/JUMPERS:</u></p> <p>TK-5: Navy Blue</p> <p>6-8: Navy Blue, Khaki or Black (Dark black/blue denim is acceptable. No faded jeans. No rips, tears, or holes.)</p> <p>TK-8: Leggings may not be worn as pants, but may be worn under skirts or dresses.</p>	<p><u>PANTS/SHORTS/SKIRTS/DRESSES/JUMPERS:</u></p> <p>*Proper size - Not too tight; no oversized clothing or sagging</p> <p>*No sweats, basketball/athletic/PE shorts</p> <p>*No "jeggings"</p> <p>*No rips/tears/holes in clothing</p> <p>*Pants should be belted and worn at the waist</p> <p>*Shorts/skirts must pass fingertip test with hands straight at sides</p>
<p><u>SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS:</u></p> <p>TK-8: Solid, Any Color</p> <p>Uniform shirt must be worn under sweatshirts/jackets.</p>	<p><u>SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS:</u></p> <p>*Cubberley and brand name logos are acceptable. No other logos are permitted.</p> <p>*No hoods on heads, except during inclement weather</p>
<p><u>SHOES/SOCKS:</u></p> <p>Any Color</p>	<p><u>SHOES/SOCKS:</u></p> <p>*Tennis shoes or PE-appropriate shoes</p> <p>*Shoes must be closed all around. No sandals.</p>
Additional Dress Code Requirements	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hats may be worn for sun protection outdoors. Hats may not be worn indoors. No PE clothes may be worn under regular clothes either before/after PE class. No large hoops or unsafe earrings/jewelry/belts. No facial piercings. During free dress days, students are still expected to abide by the dress code (right column). Students who do not wish to participate in School Spirit Dress-Up Days should plan to come in school uniform.
