| SHIRTS/SWEATERS: <br> TK-5: Solid White or Light/Dark Blue <br> (With Collar Preferred) <br> 6-8: Solid White, Light/Dark Blue, or Gold (With Collar Preferred) <br> TK-8: Cubberley Spirit Wear can be worn every day; college shirts may be worn on Fridays. | SHIRTS/SWEATERS: <br> *Proper size and not inside-out <br> *Undershirts must also be uniform colors <br> *No tank tops, spaghetti straps, halters, strapless <br> *No sports jerseys <br> *No logos except for Cubberley/District logos <br> *No non-uniform shirts/sweaters should be worn on top of uniform shirts |
| PANTS/SHORTS/SKIRTS/DRESSES/ <br> JUMPERS: <br> TK-5: Navy Blue 6-8: Navy Blue, Khaki or Black (Dark black/blue denim is acceptable. No faded jeans. No rips, tears, or holes.) <br> TK-8: Leggings may not be worn as pants, but may be worn under skirts or dresses. | PANTS/SHORTS/SKIRTS/DRESSES/ <br> JUMPERS: <br> *Proper size - Not too tight; no oversized clothing or sagging <br> *No sweats, basketball/athletic/PE shorts <br> *No "jeggings" <br> ${ }^{*}$ No rips/tears/holes in clothing <br> *Pants should be belted and worn at the waist *Shorts/skirts must pass fingertip test with hands straight at sides |
| SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS: <br> TK-8: Solid, Any Color Uniform shirt must be worn under sweatshirts/jackets. | SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS: <br> *Cubberley and brand name logos are acceptable. No other logos are permitted. *No hoods on heads, except during inclement weather |
| $\begin{aligned} & \text { SHOES/SO } \\ & \text { Any Color } \end{aligned}$ | SHOES/SOCKS: <br> *Tennis shoes or PE-appropriate shoes *Shoes must be closed all around. No sandals. |
| Additional Dress Code Requirements |  |
| - Hats may be worn for sun protection outdoors. Hats may not be worn indoors. <br> - No PE clothes may be worn under regular clothes either before/after PE class. <br> - No large hoops or unsafe earrings/jewelry/belts. No facial piercings. <br> - During free dress days, students are still expected to abide by the dress code (right column). Students who do not wish to participate in School Spirit Dress-Up Days should plan to come in school uniform. |  |
